The Board of Governors, by Deborah O'Regan, its Executive Director, having considered the application and its attached certificate finds:

1. The application is in proper form;
2. The applicant is a member of the \_\_\_\_\_ (state) State Bar in good standing and is entitled to practice in all courts of that state;
3. The applicant is an active duty member of the U.S. Armed Forces assigned to the Judge Advocate General's Corp or the U.S. Coast Guard;
